
INFORMATION NOTICE PURSUANT TO ART. 13 GDPR

AGCO S.p.A. has drawn up this Information Notice, pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 endorsed by the European Parliament and the European Council on 27 April 2016, and referred to as the General Regulation for the Protection of Personal Data (**GDPR**), to provide information on the procedures it uses to process personal data.

1) DATA CONTROLLER

The Data Controller in charge of the data processing is AGCO S.p.A. (hereafter “**AGCO**”), with registered office in Via F. Laverda, 15/17 Breganze, email address: infobreganze@agcocorp.com.

2) CATEGORIES OF PROCESSED DATA

We shall process the following personal (**Data**) that regard you in your capacity as the (**Data Subject**), i.e. common data, such as for example, identification data, master data, contact details, work employer and work duties.

Such Data shall be provided by the Data Subject:

- by completing online forms provided at the AGCO website, including newsletter subscriptions and account registration details on the AGCO website; or
- during any correspondence received from the Data Subject regarding requests for informative and commercial services provided by the AGCO website.

Collection of such Data is mandatory when subscribing to the newsletter or when registering an account on the AGCO website. AGCO is unable to accept subscriptions or Data from subjects under 16 (sixteen) years of age, under art. 8 GDPR or any other age restrictions imposed by the country of residence. Therefore, upon registering on the AGCO website, the Data Subject confirms and declares to have reached the legal age foreseen by the laws in the Country of residence.

3) PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

Your Personal Data shall be processed for the following purposes when you grant your consent:

- a) For AGCO promotional activities, including the sending via email of newsletters, commercial communications and/or advertising material on products or services provided by the Data Controller and surveys on the degree of satisfaction regarding the quality of the services;
- b) to organise events, meetings and celebrations within the scope of the promotional and corporate activities of (...).

The collection and processing of the Data for the aforementioned purposes are of an optional nature, so you are entitled not to grant your consent or withdraw the same at any moment in time.

Please be reminded that the withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

4) PROCESSING METHODS

Processing shall be performed with or without electronic media, with or without the use of automated systems, all of which suitable to memorise, manage and transmit the Data, and will include all the operations and groups of operations required by the processing in question, including the processing and management of your Data using AGCO’s management software and

the disclosure of your Data to the subjects indicated in point 6).

5) COOKIES

6) DISCLOSURE OF DATA TO THIRD PARTIES APPOINTED AS DATA PROCESSORS

Your Data shall be disclosed, to the extent where the same is necessary and functional to achieve the aforementioned purposes, to the following categories of subjects:

- to group companies which belong to the same group as AGCO.
- An updated list of data processors, if appointed, is available and can be requested from AGCO by email at the following email address infobreganze@agcocorp.com.

Your Data may be communicated to competent judicial or supervisory authorities, to public bodies and authorities as required by the laws in force.

7) STORAGE AND RETENTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Your Personal Data are stored in clouds and servers located both inside and outside the European Union, at the disposal of AGCO, the AGCO group companies who are either the owners or within the scope of the third-party enterprises appointed as data processors.

The transfer of your Data outside the European Union is subject to the implementation of suitable measures including the adoption of clauses drafted in accordance with the decisions endorsed by the European Commission.

8) DURATION OF PERSONAL DATA RETENTION

Your Personal Data shall be processed and retained for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed and, in any case, for a period not exceeding 2 years.

9) RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

You are entitled to exercise the following rights:

- a) right to access the Data: to obtain confirmation, at any moment in time, as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed, and receive information on the same;
- b) right to rectification: to obtain without undue delay rectification of inaccurate Data or the integration of the same;
- c) right to be forgotten: the right to request the erasure of your Personal Data without undue delay;
- d) right to restriction: to obtain the right to restriction of processing the data for retention purposes only;
- e) right to data portability: to obtain a copy of the processed personal data concerning you in a structured format, commonly used and readable by automatic devices, so as to facilitate transfer of such data to another data processor you provide information on;
- f) right to object: to object to the processing of your Data.

COOKIE POLICY

1. Foreword

AGCO S.p.A. collects certain information when users browse its website, in order to analyse the ways in which it is used by the user and other visitors, draw up aggregate statistics on its use and improve the browsing experience, with the help of analysis service providers.

This information includes, for example, the IP address, browser type and language, date and time, browsing duration, views and selected page elements.

AGCO S.p.A. uses cookies to collect and analyse such data.

2. What are cookies

Cookies are small text files that the websites visited by users send to their devices, where they are stored to be transmitted to the website again the next time the same user visits it again.

The so-called “third-party” cookies, on the other hand, are set by a website other than the one the user is browsing. This happens as a series of elements may be present on each website (such as images, maps, links to other domains) which are hosted by servers other than that on which the requested page is hosted.

AGCO S.p.A. uses its own and third-party cookies.

3. For what purposes are the cookies used

Cookies are used for different purposes, such as, for instance, the performing of computer authentication, session monitoring, storage of information on specific configurations concerning users accessing the site and storing their preferences. Generally speaking, they are used to improve the user's browsing experience, thanks to the personalisation of the website according to each user's browsing habits.

4. Types of cookies

Cookies are divided into different categories according to their characteristics and uses:

1. **Technical cookies**

These are used to allow browsing functions or to provide a service requested by the user. They are not used for any other purposes other than ensuring an efficient browsing experience and are normally installed directly by the website owner. Without the use of such cookies, certain operations will not be available or would be exceedingly more complex and/or less secure.

The consent of users is not required to set these types of cookies.

2. **Profiling cookies**

These are used to create user profiles and are used to send advertising message in line with the preferences shown by the same during the browsing sessions. Given the particular level of invasiveness these cookies can have regarding the user's private aspects, the EU and Italian regulations require that users must be duly informed on the use of the same and provide their specific content.

3. **Third-party cookies**

Information Notice pursuant to Art. 13 for website use

When browsing the website users may receive cookies from websites managed by other organisations (“third-party”). They are generated directly by third-party websites and integrated within the page of the hosting website.

Management of the information collected by “third-parties” is regulated by the relative Information Notices provided by the same.

AGCO S.p.A. uses session and analytic cookies.

AGCO S.p.A. also uses Google Analytics profiling cookies and the Google reCAPTCHA cookies providing antispyam protection.

Google Analytics and Google reCAPTCHA cookies are an analysis service provided by Google Inc. used to collect statistics on the website along with demographic details, interests and behaviour of the users visiting the website.

5. Managing of Cookies

Users can decide whether or not to accept cookies using their browser settings.

Partial or complete disabling of technical cookies may prevent the website from performing correctly.

Disabling profiling or “third-party” cookies will not affect the browsing experience in any manner, however disabling the Google reCAPTCHA cookies may prevent users from viewing the contact and information/availability request forms. Settings can be defined for each specific website and web applications.

For instance, the Firefox browser provides users with easy access to a control panel where it is possible to define whether or not to accept the various types of cookies and remove the same.

6. Duration of cookies

Some cookies (so-called session cookies) remain stored on the device until the browser is closed or any log-out command is given.

Other cookies remain stored on the device even after the browser is closed (so-called persistent cookies), and are available during subsequent visits to the website by users, and their expiry date is set the moment they are installed.
